The person must not have any relationship with other natural or legal persons which would give rise to a conflict of interest in the performance of his/her duties as a member of the Board. There must be no deprivation or restriction of the right to hold the relevant position applied for or to perform the functions assigned to that position. During the last 5 years, the person must not have been removed from a single-person or a collegial body of a legal entity due to improper performance of duties. The person cannot be a career civil servant holding a position in a Ministry, a Government institution or an institution under the Ministry, who is entrusted with functions related to the formation of state policy in the branch of the economic sector in which the Company, to the collegial body of which the person is a candidate, operates. The person cannot be elected or appointed as a state politician and a civil servant of political (personal) trust in accordance with the law.
